This is the information we need to complete the permits:

1. Type of Licenses you need (Adult, Senior, Guest, Active Military, Child- including child's age)
2. Name for each license (Guest licenses will have the homeowner's last name.)
3. Address in Highland Lakes

2 Guest King 101 Cheesman Lake Circle	\$40
Child Eli King 101 Cheesman Lake Circle, age 10	\$8
Total	\$58

Prices for this year:

Adult \$35 (Property owners, spouse, resident renters, and adult children in household)

Senior \$10 (65+)

Active Military No charge, but need a permit

Guest \$20

Child up to 5 years- no charge, 6 -12 \$8, 13 - 17 \$15
