

**IF YOU HAVE WATERCRAFT STORED AT ELK LAKE, PLEASE READ AND COMPLY.**

We have almost 40 canoes, paddle boats, trailers, and fishing boats clustered around the storage rack at Elk Lake. We aren't sure who owns them. We don't know if they have been abandoned or if they are still safe on water.

In the interest of resident safety and in maintaining the beauty of Elk Lake, the Board is addressing this issue. **If your watercraft is STORED at Elk Lake**, please help us clean up and organize the storage area.

1. **On April 1 from 8:00 AM to noon**, please come to the Community Building to **register your watercraft and pick up a storage sticker** to affix to your watercraft. You will need to provide complete owner information and a detailed description of your watercraft. **Wendy and Ben Boals** will register your watercraft and give you a sticker. The **sticker is free and is good for two years**.
2. **Affix the sticker** on the left side of the front of your watercraft so it is visible when it is tethered to the rack.
3. Ensure your watercraft is **secured with a lock and chain**.

**If you aren't available on April 1**, please contact either **Ben Boals at 608.558.0038** or **Wendy Boals at 608.214.6235**, and they will register your watercraft and provide the storage sticker.

Owners have from **April 1 to May 31 to register and sticker** their watercraft. Any **watercraft not claimed and identified by June 2023 will be considered abandoned and removed** from the storage area.
